
#### **OBITUARY**

The Gloucestershire Centre of the Caravan & Motorhome Club sadly announce the death of former Centre Chairman PETER HAYNES.

Peter and his wife Moira, joined the Gloucestershire Centre in 1998 and became active members, running rallies and both taking Centre Officer positions.

Peter took on several Committee roles, as Rally Equipment Officer and Rally Registrar, before becoming Vice Chairman in 2013-14.

He took over the Chairmanship from Jeanette Seabright in 2015.



His dedication to the Centre was highlighted in May 2016 when they sold their house in Hardwick Bank Road, Northway, Tewkesbury and moved to Hirwaun in South Wales.

This move did not deter Peter or Moira, and they continued commuting once a month to Committee meetings in Gloucester, as well as attending many rallies.

Sadly, ill health became a problem for Peter and restricted their caravan leisure time in recent years.

The Centre would like to express their thanks for all Peter did, and deepest sympathy to Moira and the rest of the family.
